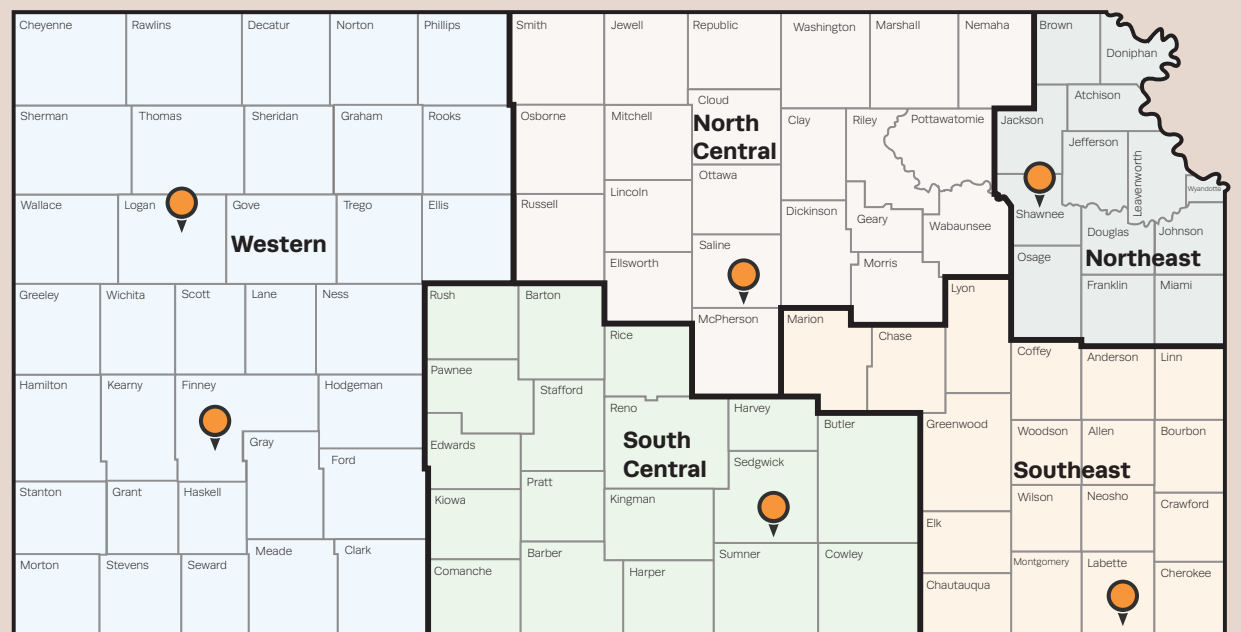

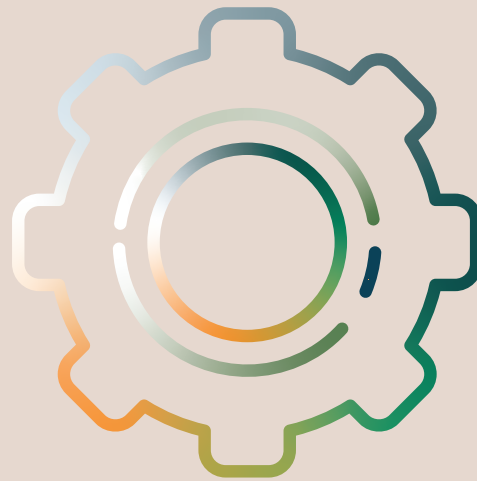

62% field crop production

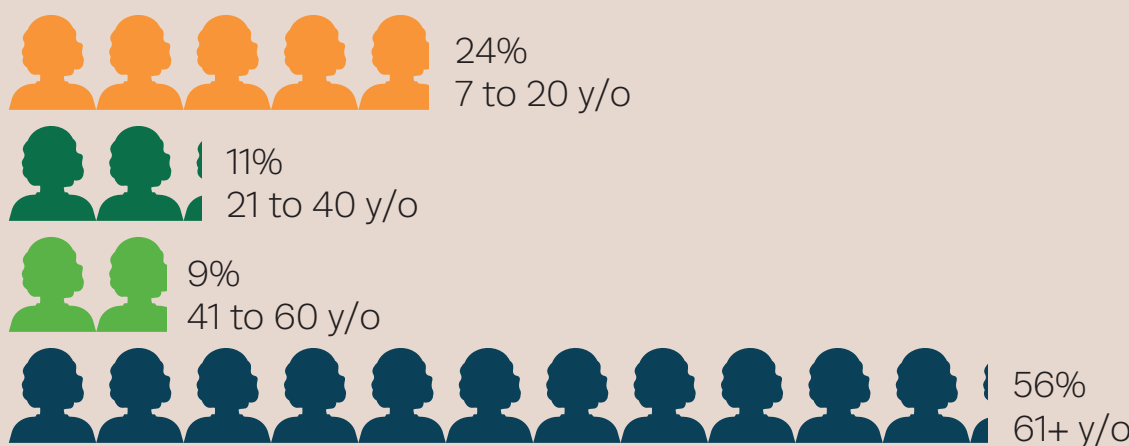
